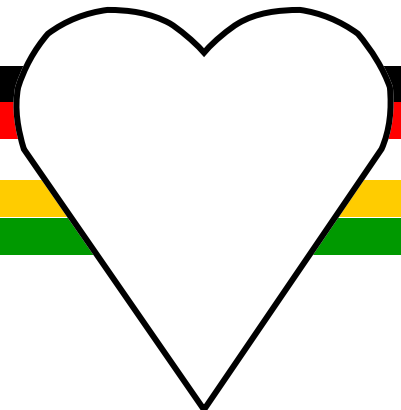
## PRINT PAGE 1 ON WHITE CARDSTOCK

(Cut this section out and discard)

### Notebook Pocket for Wordless Book:

1. Print this page on white cardstock.
2. Cut out the pocket .
3. Adhere the pocket to another sheet of white cardstock by applying a strip of adhesive along the left edge, the bottom edge, and the short right edge. Do not glue the diagonal edge.
4. Punch holes along the left edge so that the pocket can be placed in your notebook.
5. Once the edges have dried, slide your wordless book into the pocket.

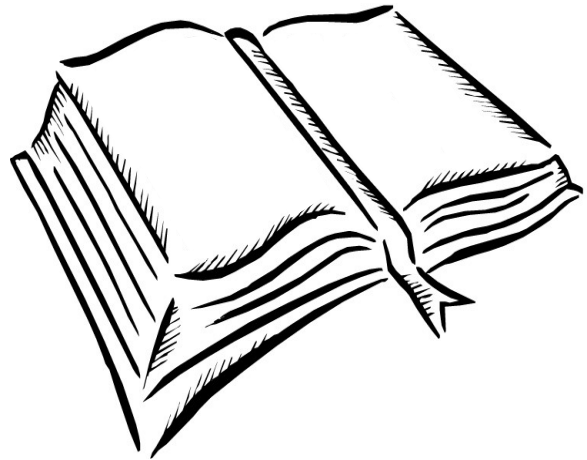
# My Wordless Book

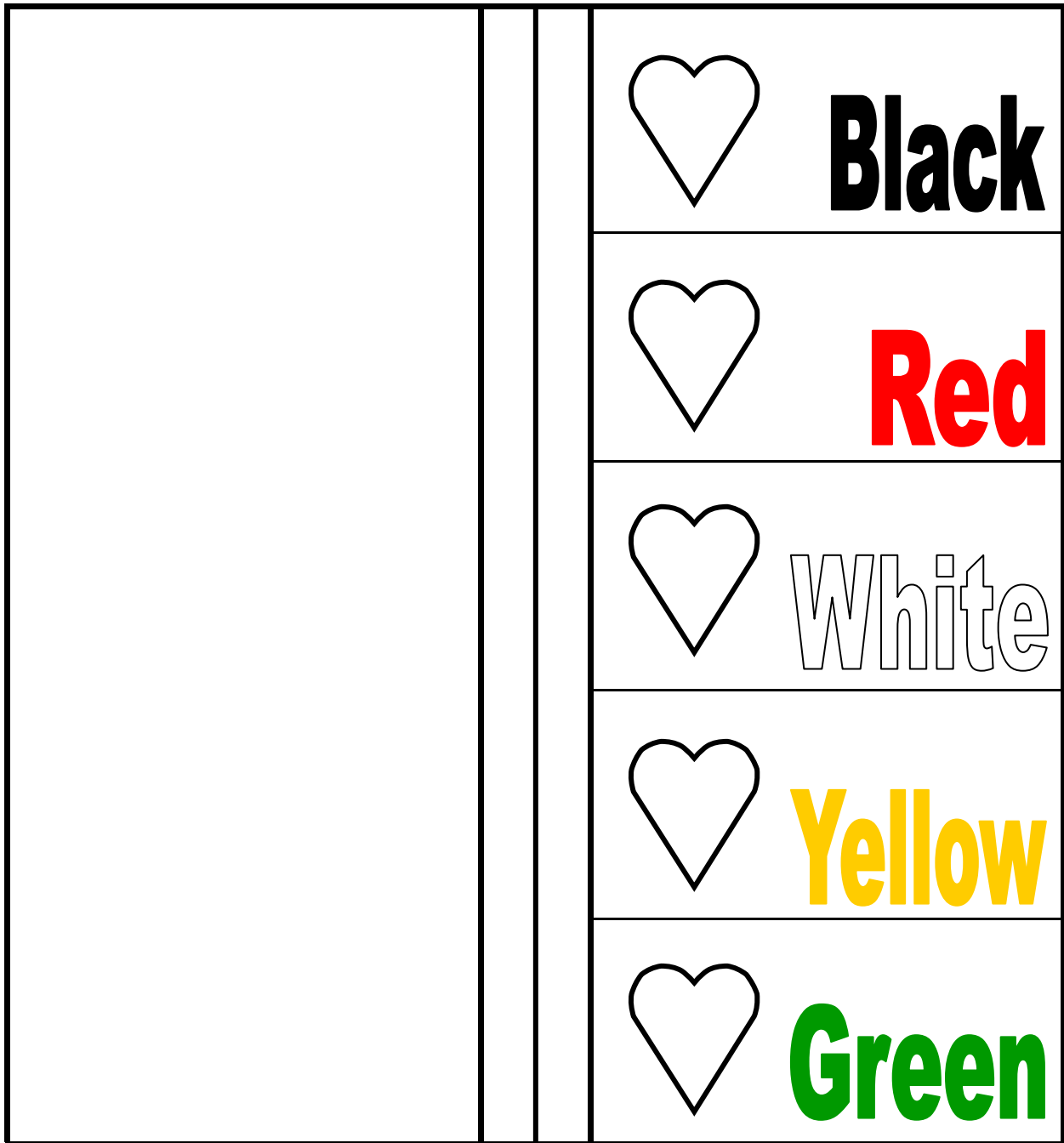

**This is the cover for the tab book on page 3:**

1. Cut around the outer edges and fold down center line.
2. Tuck the tab book from page 3 inside the cover and staple 2 or 3 times down the left side.
3. If you would like, you can color the wordless book. We colored the binding brown, the first layer (nearest the bottom) black, the second red, left a white space and colored the last layer up yellow. We colored the open pages green because learning how to use the Wordless Book is helping us to grow.

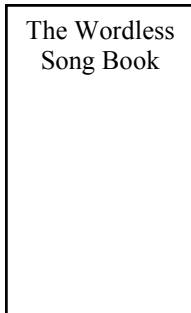


1. Cut around the outside edges.
2. Fold along center line.
3. Cut tabs to first line.
4. Staple inside cover.
5. Color the hearts to match the color word.
6. Lift the tabs and write what the color represents in the wordless book.

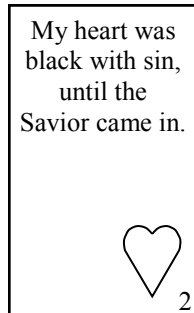
### Wordless Song Mini Book:

1. Cut out each of the double page pieces.
2. Fold each of the pieces in half so that there are words on each side.
3. Stack the folded pieces in order and staple along the left side.
4. Color the symbols on each page the appropriate color.
5. Color the Wordless Book to match the cover of the tab book.

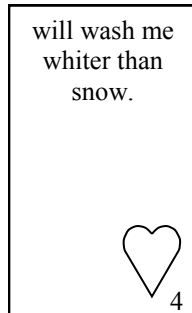
Before stapling the pages, make sure they are in this order:



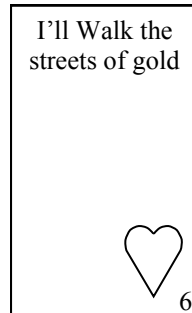
The back of this page should be blank.



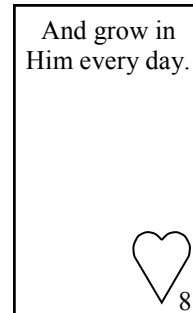
The back of this page should be page 3.



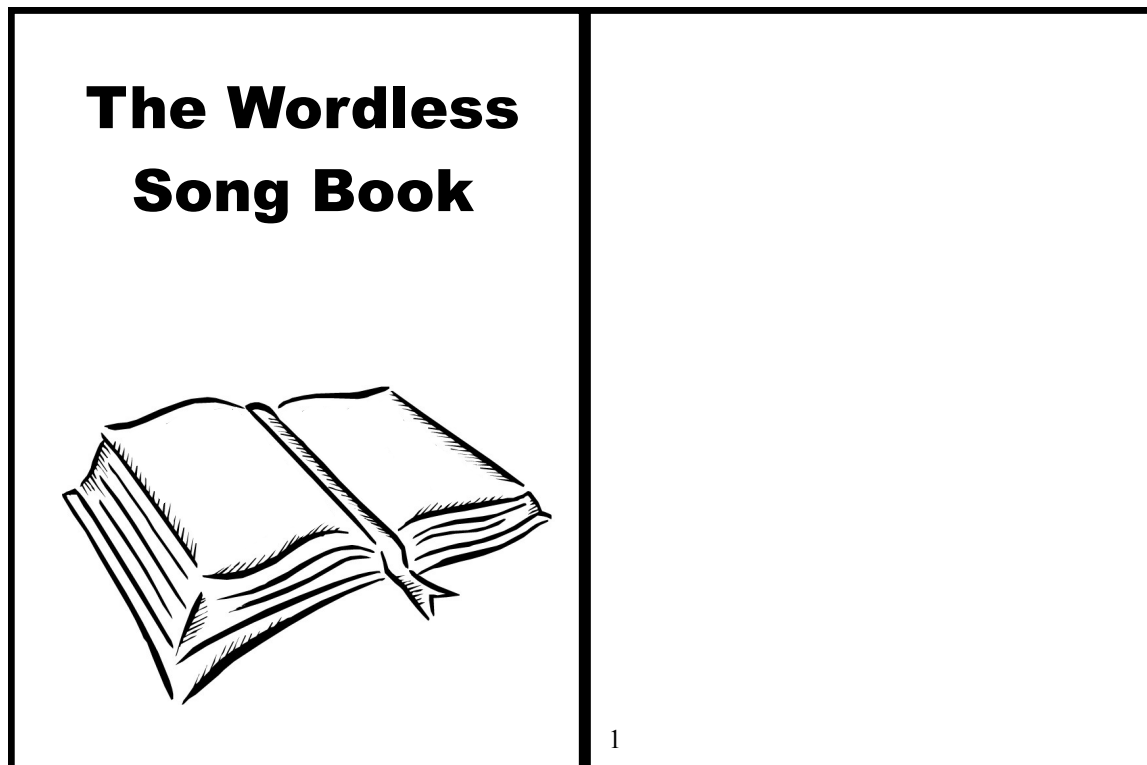
The back of this page should be page 5.



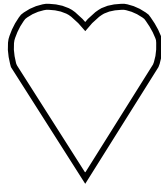
The back of this page should be page 7

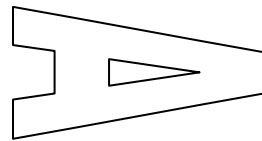
# ABC's of Salvation
