Directions: Cut out page 2 and fold on dotted line. Cut out page 1 and fold in half. Glue the top half only of page 1 (the tracks page) onto the top inside page of the cover (page 2).

Glue the answer piece onto the bottom inside cover so you can see the answers when you lift the pictures. Glue into lapbook.

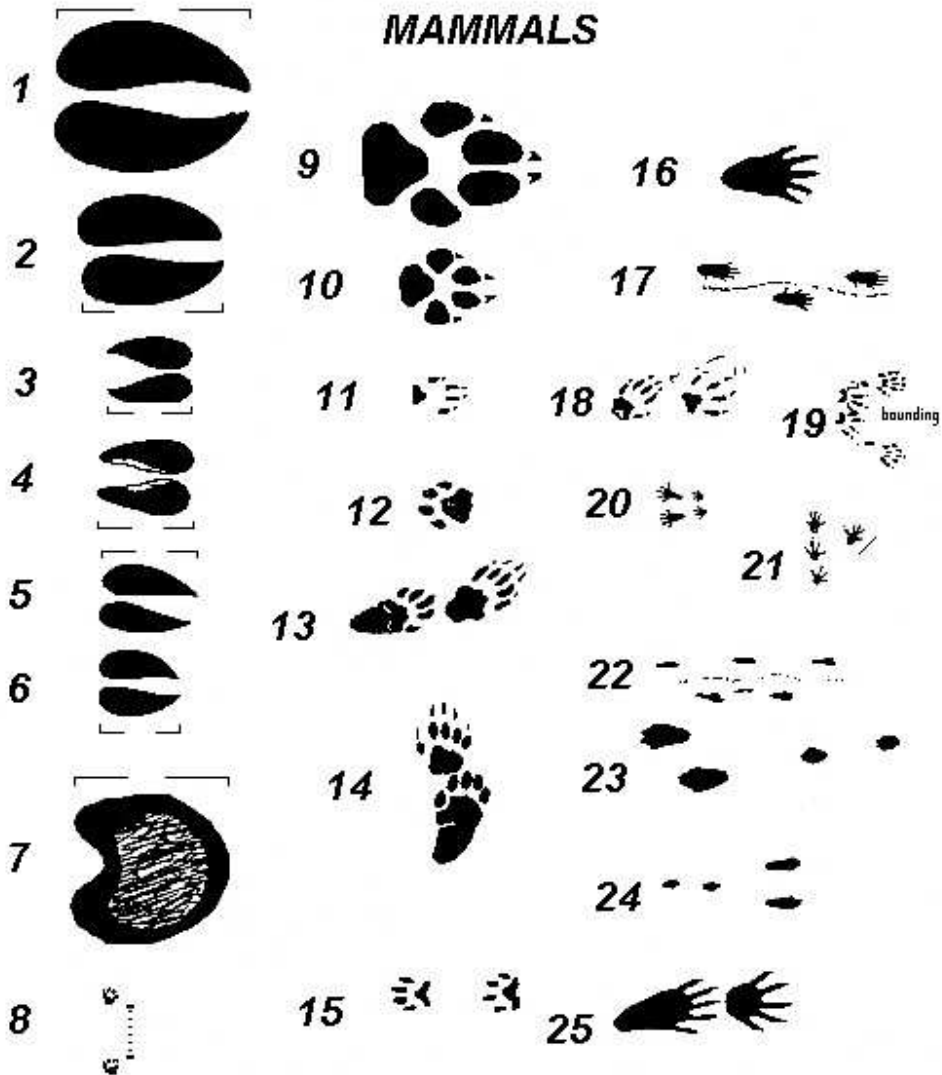
If you prefer, students may write the answers inside instead of gluing the answer sheet.
