





## Sun Mini Books:

\*For younger students you may want to have them dictate their answers so you can type them. Then they can cut and paste the answers into the mini-books.





The center line on this book should be cut so that it forms two flaps.



### Writing Inserts:

These inserts were created for two reasons. First, mini books printed on colored paper may be difficult write in. Secondly, some students find it easier to write using the lines as guides.

- 1) Print inserts on white paper
- 2) Cut around the dotted lines
- 3) Glue into the corresponding mini books.

\*It may be easier to do the writing before they are glued into the mini books.
