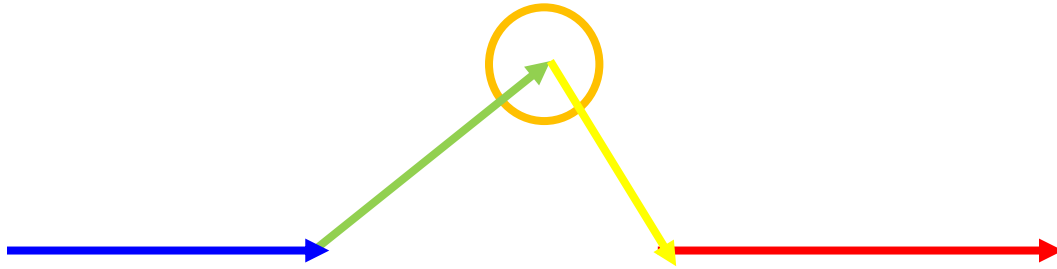


FIVE PARTS OF A PLOT:



Exposition: The beginning of a story where the characters are introduced and the setting (background info) is revealed.

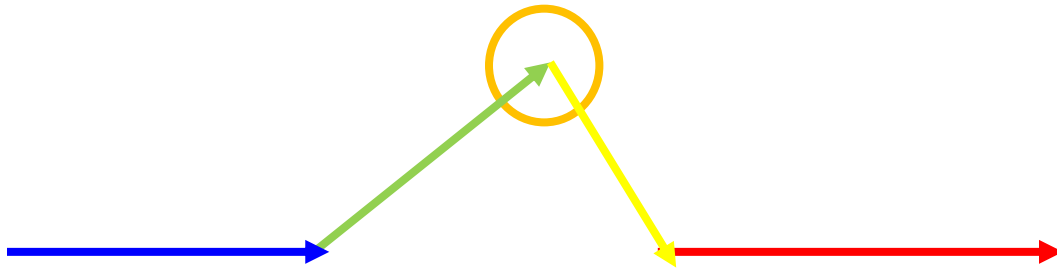
Rising Action: This is where a problem(s) arise and tension builds in the story.

Climax: The most exciting point and turning point of the story. The reader wants to know what happens next.

Falling Action: The action that follows directly after the climax. This is where the problem(s) begins unwinding.

Resolution: This is the end of the story where the problem(s) is worked out.
